Norm will continue entering the music on the Center's calendar. Whomever uses the Center will be responsible for making sure the building is empty and locked up.

The ground was wet and the tires left large ruts. The ground requires gravel to be spread. DS will contact the contractor who did the damage requesting help with its repair.
